Statement of Issue

The City Council is asked to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a License Agreement between the City of Huntington Beach and Southern California Edison for the purpose of maintaining existing traffic light facilities located on Center Avenue in Huntington Beach.



Financial Impact

The License Fee will begin upon the execution of this Agreement, with subsequent annual payments as per the schedule of rents below. Payments will be budgeted from 10085304.64620 Traffic Signal Maintenance Account.

Analysis

- In 1993 the City installed traffic signals on Southern California Edison owned properties.
- The existing License Agreement has expired, and City Council approval is required for a new five-year agreement.
- SCE has prepared a new License agreement, which has been approved by the City Attorney as well as the Public Works Department.
