Continuing Resolution will not pass in its current form. It runs out midnight on 12/20. Plan B, which is likely, is a stripped version and will include disaster relief. That version will be a bare bones CR that will run through 3/14/25.

Appropriations activity- no bills done by the end of year. Late February early March. \$400M for communities hosing 2028 Olympics.

2. State Update- Louie Brown, Kahn Soares & Conway

Leg session started first Monday of December with swearing in of new members.

Special election February 25, 2025. And Governor is required to introduce 25/26 fiscal plan.

Dr Steven Choi as new State Senator taking Dave Min's seat.

Keeping an eye out for legislation involving Voter ID, residential care facilities, and ADU's. There is an early introduction of AB25 Voter ID and Election Integrity Act – requiring government issue id.

Both Senate and Assembly will be maxed at introducing 50 bills per representative.
