A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH AFFIRMING THAT THE PUBLIC LIBRARY WILL NOT BE SOLD AND THAT BOOKS WILL NOT BE BANNED

WHEREAS, the Huntington Beach Public Library is a long-standing public institution funded by taxpayers and valued by the residents of Huntington Beach; and

WHEREAS, the public has expressed concerns regarding the future of the library and the treatment of library materials, prompting the need for clarity from the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Huntington Beach does hereby resolve as follows:

- 1. The Huntington Beach Public Library shall not be sold. It will remain a publicly owned asset; and
 - 2. Books shall not be banned from the Huntington Beach Public Library.
