The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) would like to thank the West Orange County Water Board (WOCWB) for its cooperation with OCTA to complete the relocation of WOCWB Feeder No. 2 at Westminster Blvd (CN-1087) as part of the I-405 Improvement Project (Project). As mentioned in previous communications from OCTA to WOCWB staff, the Project is now complete and OCTA is finishing the utility closeout phase of the Project.

In accordance with the terms of Utility Agreement UK151087, WOCWB is required to submit a Notice of Completion form to OCTA upon completion of the work. Per OCTA's records, work associated with CN-1087 was completed on or around October of 2019. The Notice of Completion is also required to close out the associated Caltrans Encroachment Permit No. 12-17-N-MC-0655. OCTA has filled out the attached Notice of Completion on behalf of WOCWB, and kindly requests that WOCWB sign the form and return to OCTA within 30 days of receipt of this letter. If OCTA does not receive a response within the specified timeframe, it shall be deemed by OCTA for our Project records that WOCWB consents to the Notice of Completion as provided.
