



# **FY 2025/26 Sewer Lining Project Construction Contract CC1845**

June 2, 2026 City Council Meeting

# Background

The City's Utility Division implements an annual sewer lining program to rehabilitate ageing sewer mains identified through CCCTV inspections and maintenance history.

This project includes lining approximately 29,850 linear feet of sewer main using UV CIPP technology across multiple pipe diameters (8"–15"). Work also includes rehabilitation of 66 manholes and restoration of service laterals.

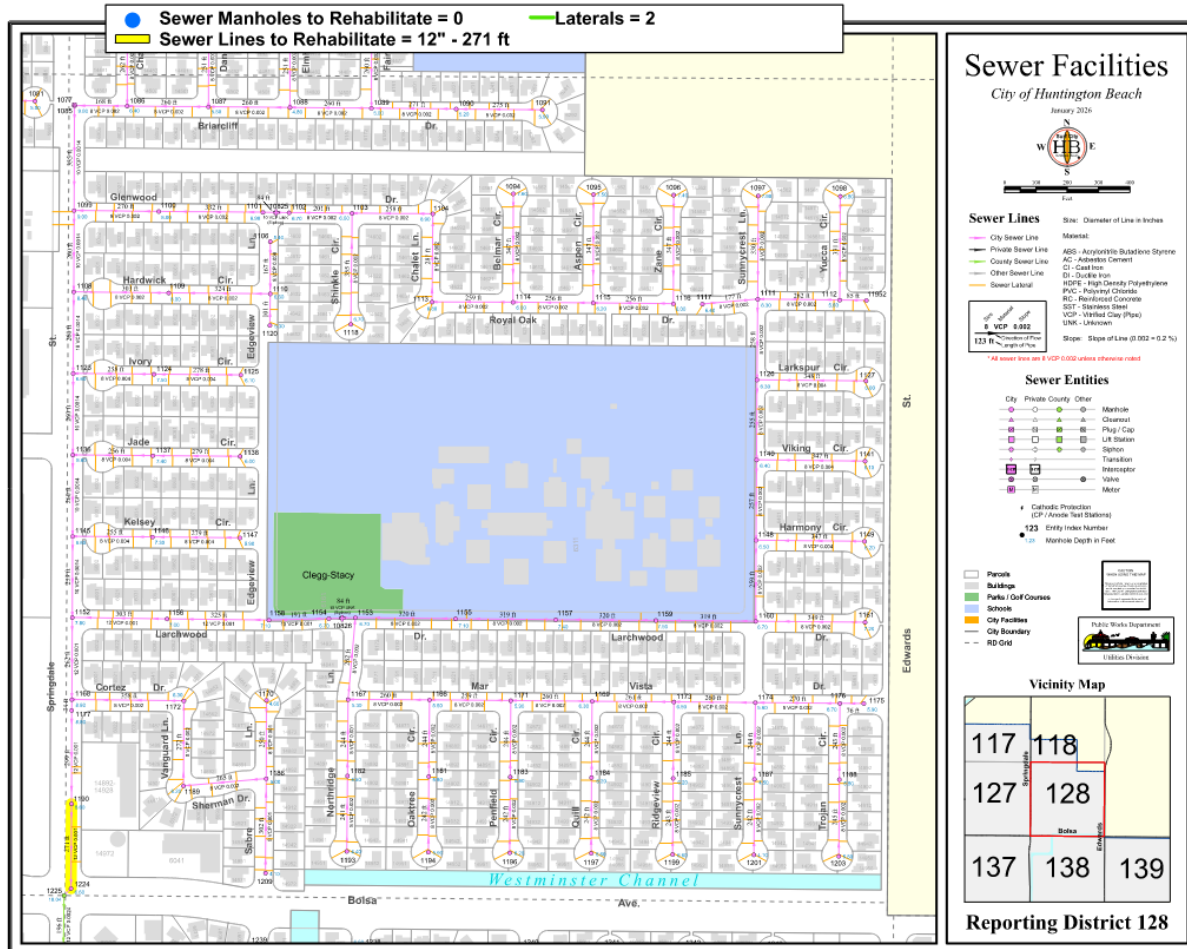
Project locations are shown in the accompanying maps.

The Sewer Lining Project is essential to public health and safety, in addition to preserving the life of the City's existing sewer infrastructure. This project helps prevent sewer overflows, tree root intrusion, groundwater seepage, and calcium build-up.



# Projects

## FY 2025/26 Sewer Lining Project CC1845

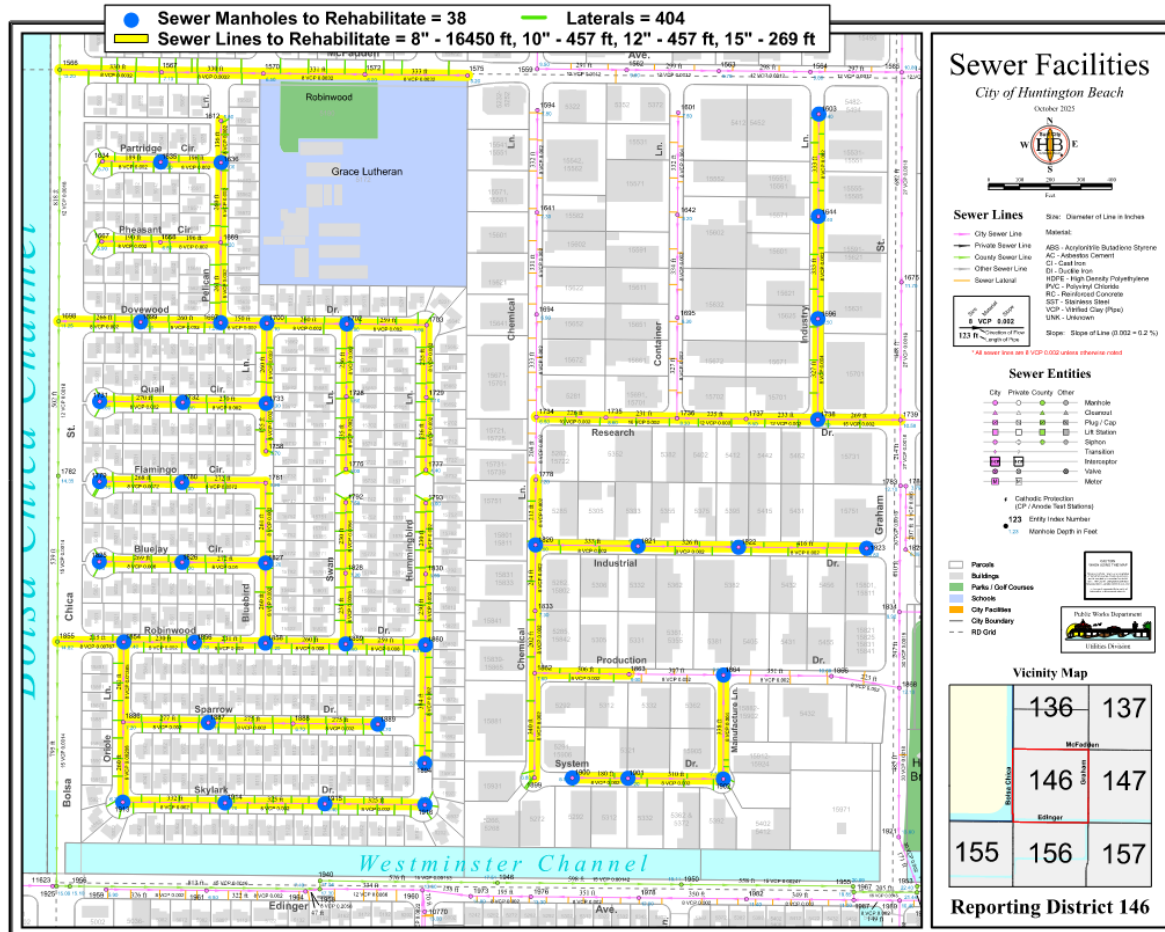


- New UV Sewer Lining Cure-in-Place Pipe (CIPP) Technology
- Estimated 29,850 linear feet of existing sewer main to be lined
- Long Term Sewer Main Infrastructure Protection from groundwater seepage through minor cracks and from tree root intrusion.
- Total of 66 manhole's to be rehabilitated

# Funding and Schedule

## Current Funding:

- The FY 2025-26 Sewer Lining Project is fully funded through the Sewer Improvement Fund, Account No. 51189028.82600
- No additional appropriations will be required

## Schedule:

- Design Phase completed 24/25
- Construction to begin early summer 2026
