# ONSITE ACTIVITIES



# BANNING IMPROVEMENTS

Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB's) are completed  
Street light work under design. Improvements with a few  
changes/additions to the utility pole mounted street lights

LeBard Park (under construction, completed mid-Sept)

Gisler Park – completed.

## OCTA/SCAG AWARD:

\$5M for Banning Roundabout along with improvements along Newland (Adams-PCH) & Bushard (Adams-Brookhurst) includes planting 140 new trees, enhanced bike lanes, replacing sidewalks & radar feedback signs

\$3.9M for Hamilton between Magnolia & Brookhurst includes new landscaped medians, curb & gutter, sidewalks, 50 new trees, enhanced bike lanes.

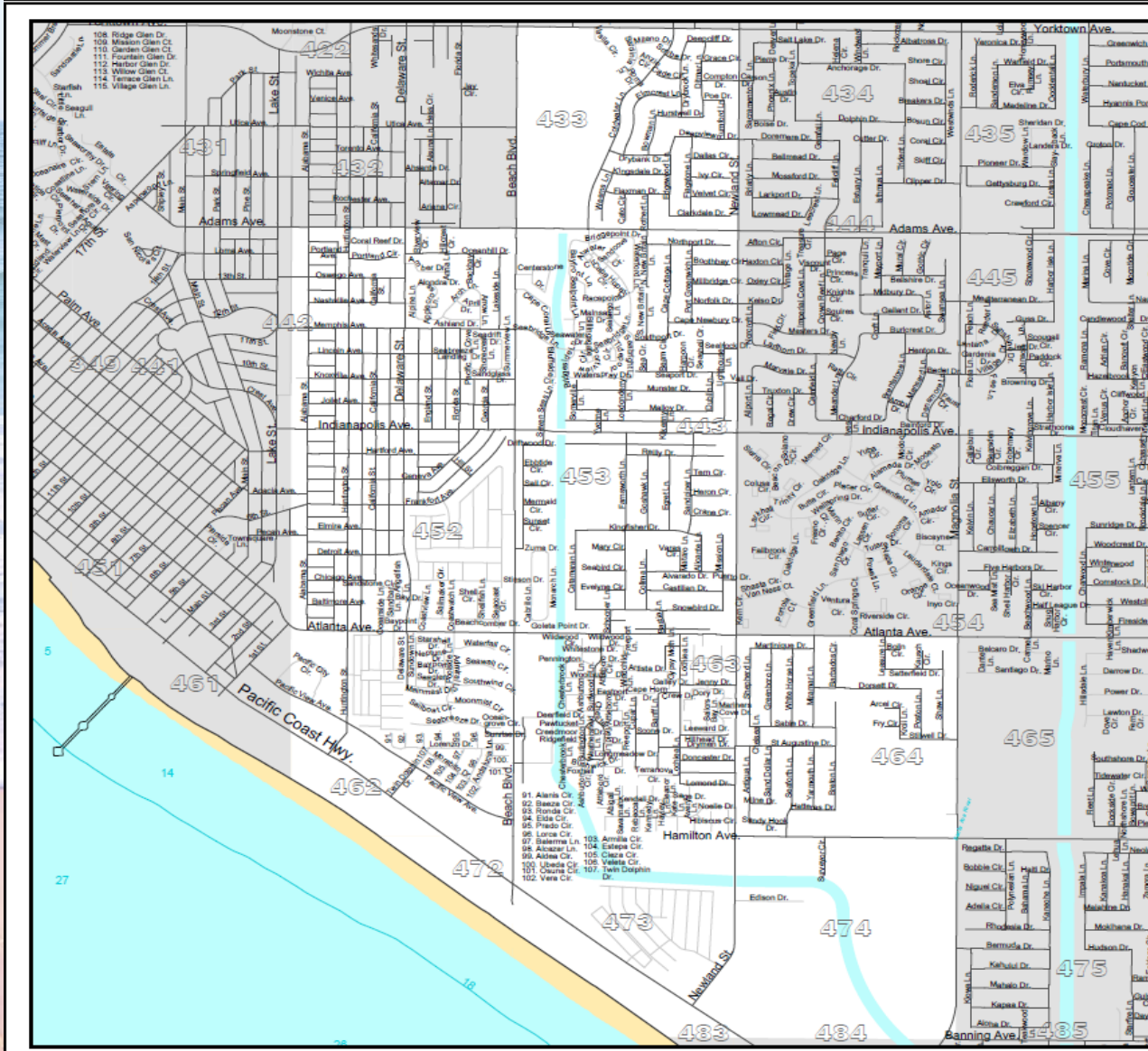


# DRAIN SYSTEM AT THE CORNER OF HAMILTON AND MAGNOLIA

- JULY-AUG: Slurry seal of streets (now)

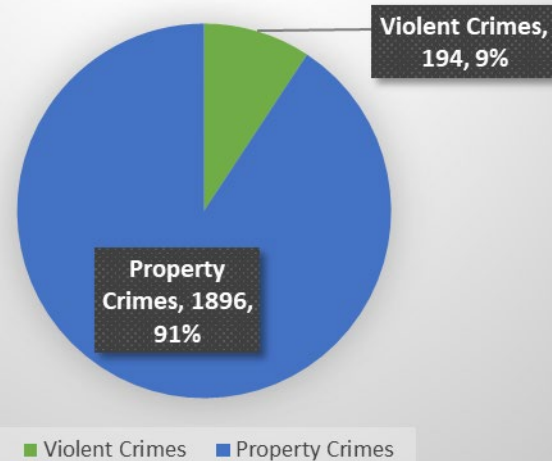

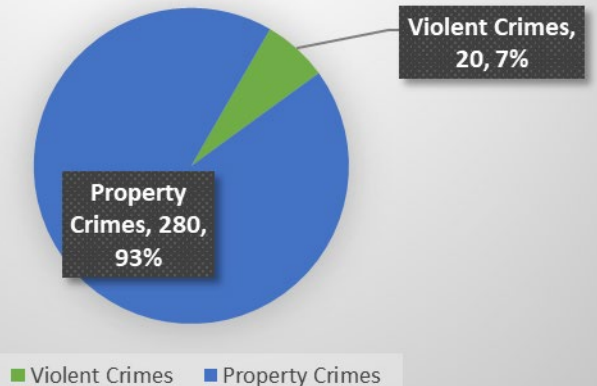

Part I Crimes

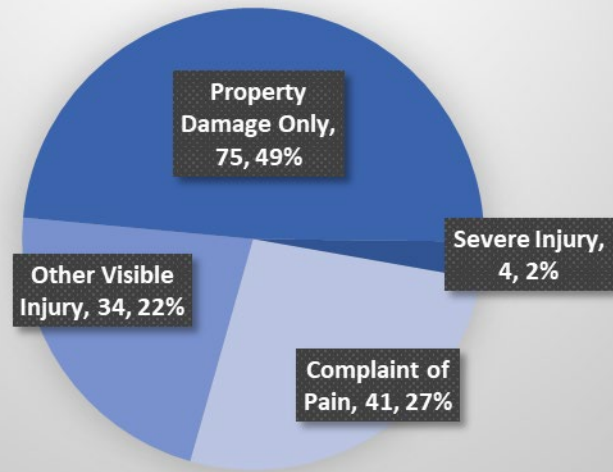


- Citywide - Part I Crimes are down 6.7%
