- Wet Well
- Valve vault
- Gravity Sewer
- Force Main
- Infrastructure Investment
- Originally constructed in 1972



Scope of Work



- Install new valve vault, wet well, gravity sewer, force main, and emergency gas generator & enclosure, and associated site improvements
- Utility Coordination
- Develop plans, specifications, material testing and estimate
- Environmental documentation and regulatory agency permits
- Construction engineering and environmental monitoring



Funding and Schedule

Current Funding:

- Sewer Service Fund (511): \$3,900,000
- Sewer Development Fee (210): \$1,500,000

Schedule:

- Design – Complete FY 23/24
- Construction – To Begin Spring FY 25/26

Admiralty Bridge Rehabilitation CC1450



- Concrete deck
- Steel Guard Railing
- Barrier Wall
- Street Lighting
- Utility Coordination
- Traffic Infrastructure
- Originally constructed in 1961



Scope of Work



- Install new deck, barrier walls, guardrails, refurbish existing steel beams, steel lighting, traffic infrastructure, pedestrian sidewalk, and other associated bridge repairs or improvements
- Utility Coordination
- Develop plans, specifications, material testing and estimate
- Environmental documentation and regulatory agency permits
- Construction engineering and environmental monitoring



Funding and Schedule

Current Funding:

- Federal HBRR (Highway Bridge Replacement & Rehabilitation) Grant Fund: \$3,280,000
- Infrastructure Fund: \$500,000
- Measure M Fund: \$2,100,000
- Department of Transportation HBP Grant Fund (Caltrans): \$1,916,490

Schedule:

- Design – Complete FY 22/23
- Construction – In Progress, Mid-March
