ORDINANCE NO. 4279

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH AMENDING CHAPTER 2.64.040 TO THE HUNTINGTON BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING COMMUNITY AND LIBRARY SERVICES COMMISSION

The City Council of the City of Huntington Beach does herby ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2023, to increase efficiency, the City Council directed the City Manager to facilitate the adjusting of Boards and Commissions such that those with direct Councilmember appointments be reduced or limited to a 7-member Board or Commission with one appointee for each Councilmember and no more.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Huntington Beach does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2.64.040 of the Huntington Beach Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.64.040 Composition

The Community and Library Services Commission shall solely consist of seven members individually appointed by City Council. Any vacancies will be filled per Section 2.64.050 and 2.64.060 of this Chapter.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its adoption.

2.64.040 Composition

Members of the Community Services Commission in good standing are hereby appointed to the Community and Library Services Commission. Any vacancies created by these members will be filled per Sections 2.64.050 and 2.64.060 of this chapter.

All current members of the Library Board of Trustees in good standing are hereby appointed to the Community and Library Services Commission until their current terms sunset, from the time of the adoption of the ordinance codified in this chapter. Vacancies created by members of the Library Board of Trustees will permanently remain unfilled. Following the sunset of all Library Board of Trustee's current terms, t The Community and Library Services Commission shall solely consist of seven members individually appointed by City Council. Any vacancies will be filled per Sections 2.64.050 and 2.64.060 of this chapter.
