# LEGISLATIVE DRAFT HBMC CHAPTER 13.08

### Chapter 12.08

#### 13.08.070 Dogs and Other Animals

- A. No Person having the care, charge or control of any animal, domesticated or wild, shall permit or allow said animal to be, under any circumstances or conditions, on the Pier or on or upon that Beach or Adjacent Beach Area bounded by the Beach Service Road and the Pacific Ocean, including the Water Activity Zone, unless expressly permitted by a specific event permit. event it is a This section shall not apply to a police service animal, or guide dog, signal dog or service dog as defined in Penal Code Section 365.5, except that upon those This section shall not apply to the Adjacent Beach Areas, and the Water Activity Zone, located north of the line created by extending the northern curb line of 22nd Street to the Pacific Ocean to Seapoint Avenue, wherein dogs constrained by a leash no longer than six feet in length are permitted.
- B. No Person shall permit any animal, domesticated or wild, to be left unattended on the Beach or Adjacent Beach Area.
