Project list for Fiscal Year 2024/25 funded by SB 1: The Road Repair and Accountability Act

April 2, 2024

BACKGROUND

 Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant transportation shortfalls statewide.



NEED/WHY/BENEFITS

- Based on the City of Huntington Beach's population, it is estimated the City will receive \$5,079,178 in FY 2024/25 for use on eligible street and transportation projects.
- A pre-requisite to receiving the funds is the submittal of a City Council resolution to identify proposed projects that will utilize this funding.

DETAILS

- The proposed Capital Improvement Program (CIP)
 Budget for FY 2024/25 identifies the use of these
 funds, in addition to other local funds, for the annual
 Arterial Rehabilitation Project.
- Proposed arterial segments to rehabilitate:
 - Bolsa Avenue (Bolsa Chica to Edwards)
 - 17th Street (Main to Palm)
