

Approve Amendment #4 to C-3-2654

Orange County Transportation Authority for I-405 Improvement Project

November 18, 2025

BACKGROUND

- Initial work for the I-405 project started in 2001 planning and programming
- OCTA awarded design-build project to OC405 Builders January 2017
- OCTA entered into Cooperative Agreements with all of the local agencies along the project corridor in 2016 to facilitate tasks needed to complete the project and compensate agencies for expenses/efforts and pavement impacts due to project detours
- The current amendment allows OCTA to pay Huntington Beach an additional \$1,331,000 for pavement impacts
- Staff has continued to work with Caltrans to finalize the Freeway Maintenance Agreement, which is being presented separately



NEED/WHY/BENEFITS

- The Cooperative Agreement outlines various efforts that each party will undertake or participate in to complete the project
- The agreement also includes financial reimbursement terms for various City efforts including \$682,737 for impacts to City arterial pavement due to construction detours
- Amendment to current agreement is needed to authorize payment of an additional \$1,331,000 to the City for pavement impacts beyond what was originally anticipated



DETAILS

- The City has already received \$682,737 for pavement mitigation costs – pavement life impacts due to freeway detours onto local streets
- A post construction analysis identified impacts beyond what was originally expected
- Current agreement authorizes an additional reimbursement amount of \$1,331,000 to compensate the City for the additional impacts – primarily on Bolsa Avenue
- The amendment also includes a minor update for completion of the Freeway Maintenance Agreement with Caltrans

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the amendment to Cooperative
 Agreement C-3-2654 with OCTA and authorize the
 City Manager to execute the agreement
