



# **Professional Services Contracts for On-Call Transportation Engineering**

# Background

- The Public Works Department requires on-call transportation engineering consulting services for as-needed support to assist with the design and construction of Capital Improvement Program (CIP) projects.
- In October 2025, the City advertised a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for on-call Transportation Engineering Services.
- Twenty submittals received.
- Review board ranked the submittals and is recommending the award of six on-call contracts.



# Contracts

- The Public Works Department is recommending entering into on-call contracts with six engineering firms.
- Each contract is proposed for a not-to-exceed amount of \$1 million. Public Works will issue a request-for-proposal for each task, review proposals for scope and fee, and issue a purchase order for the negotiated amount. All tasks will be funded within each project's individual CIP budget or other budgeted services.
- Each contract duration will be three years.
- The City does not guarantee any amount of work.



# Recommendation

- Approve and authorize the execution of on-call Professional Services contracts with the following firms; Advantec Consulting Engineers, Inc., AGA Engineers, Inc., Fehr & Peers, Inc., FPL and Associates, Inc., HW Lochner, Inc., and LG2WB Engineers, Inc., dba Linscott, Law and Greenspan Engineers
