This incident location was the **liquor store and the liquor store owner**.

Remarks= [Liquor store owner and multiple witnesses in the parking lot stated Victor was arguing with a shirtless male. Witnesses stated Victor pulled a knife on the shirtless male which prompted the physical altercation. Victor was extremely intoxicated to the point his statement was inconsistent. Victor initially told me there was a physical fight inside the bar and then retracted his statement. At one point he "pled the 5th" officers had to locate other witnesses because Victor's statement was so inconsistent. The other males involved stated they were breaking the fight up. The surveillance cameras in the area were not able to record the incident.
