Charter Amendment Measure A

“Shall proposed Charter Amendment No. 1, which provides that commencing in 2026, for all municipal elections, the City: may require Voter Identification for elections; provide more in-person voting locations; and monitor ballot drop-boxes, be approved?”

Charter Amendment Measure B

“Shall proposed Charter Amendment No. 2, which provides that the only flags to be displayed by the City on City property are the United States Flag, The State of California Flag, the County of Orange Flag, the City of Huntington Beach Flag, the POW-MIA Flag, the six Armed Forces Flags, the Olympic Flag during the Summer Olympic Games, and any other flag if authorized by a unanimous vote of the City Council, be approved?”

Measure B – PASSED	Yes	35,231

Charter Amendment Measure C

“Shall proposed Charter Amendment No. 3 to:
commencing in 2026, require the City to adopt a two-
year budget; update the procedures to cancel a regular
City Council meeting; update the process to fill a City
Council vacancy; and amend outdated phrases, syntax,
dates, pronouns, and titles be approved?”

Measure C – FAILED
