



# **MOU Between the City of Huntington Beach and City of Newport Beach Regarding the Huntington Beach Navigation Center**

June 16, 2026

# Partnership Overview

The City of Newport Beach and City of Huntington Beach wish to form a collaborative homeless response partnership.

- ✓ Access to 10 reserved beds at the Huntington Beach Navigation Center (7 male / 3 female).
- ✓ Beds include housing navigation, case management, meals, shelter operations, referrals, and supportive services.
- ✓ Newport Beach may utilize additional beds at a per diem rate based on availability.
- ✓ The partnership supports a regional approach to homelessness and coordinated service delivery.



# Outreach and Operational Structure

- Newport Beach will fully fund a part-time Outreach Case Manager position.
- Case Manager will provide shelter referrals, resource coordination, and housing-focused engagement.
- 15 hours/week dedicated to Newport Beach field work and 5 hours/week for administrative coordination and follow-up.
- Newport Beach will fund outreach vehicle costs, including vehicle preparation, supplies, insurance, technology, and operating expenses.
- Huntington Beach will retain operational oversight of the Navigation Center and shelter services.



# Financial and Terms Agreement

- ✓ Annual revenue to Huntington Beach: up to \$538,200.
- ✓ 10 reserved HBNC beds: \$480,000 annually.
- ✓ Part-time outreach case management services: \$31,200 annually.
- ✓ Vehicle and operating costs funded by Newport Beach, including one-time vehicle preparation fee.
- ✓ 1-year agreement term with 2 optional extensions, annual 3% CPI adjustments beginning in Year 2.
