


Shoplifting 2022 Data






• Total: 669 Incidents – 67% Unknown Suspect


Robberies 2022 Data







Total 106 Robberies


Robberies 2022 Data






• Total 37 Estes Robberies

Enforcement

- Public Safety Cameras
 - Adding 25 additional public safety cameras (work with IT)
 - Divided among the area commands
 - 5 cameras per fiscal year
- Proactive patrol coordinated by Area Commanders once a quarter to address areas impacted by crime
 - 1 Lieutenant (Area Commander)
 - 1 Sergeant
 - 4 Officers

Enforcement

- Coordinate with Special Investigations Bureau (SIB) to conduct operations
 - Bait Merchandise
 - Parking Lot operations

Future Goal:

- Request 2 additional officers to the Police Department's Table of Organization
 - 2 Detectives to review quality of life issues/incidents affecting businesses
 - Detectives will review all misdemeanor cases to determine if additional charges can be brought forward
 - When staffing levels are sufficient, this issue will be brought back to council for implementation
