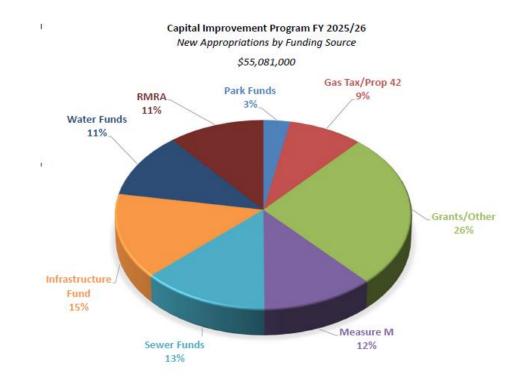
FY 25/26 CIP BUDGET

- ➤ Enterprise Funds (*Drainage, Water, and Sewer*)
- ➤ Special Revenue Funds (Measure M, Gas Tax, Prop 42, RMRA, PEG, PD Dif, Park DIF, Quimby, Traffic Impact Fee)
- ➤ Grants/Other (Caltrans/OCTA/Safe Routes to School)

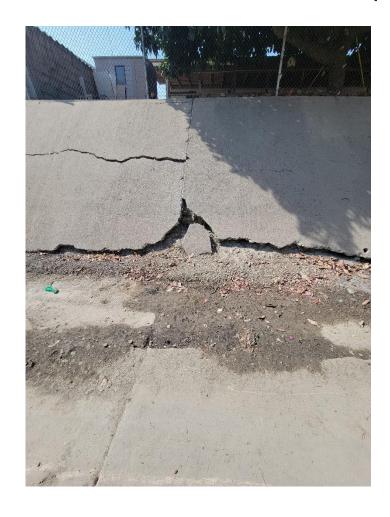

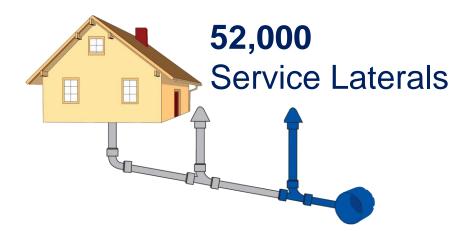
