

Report of Effect on Proposed Initiative

Community-Parent Guardian Review Board

Citizen Initiative

Repeal Ordinance No. 4318 by Deleting Huntington Beach Municipal Code Chapter 2.66 – Community-Parent Guardian Review Board for Procurement of Children's Library Materials, and Adding Section 2.30.090 – Selection and Use of Library Materials.

- On January 21, 2025, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2025-04 accepting the Certificate as to Verification of Signatures from the Orange County Registrar of Voters.
- On January 21, 2025, the City Council ordered a "Report of Effect of Proposed Initiative" to be given within 30 days. Staff is now returning with this Report for the above initiative.



Analysis – General Election

- Pursuant to Elections Code 1405(a), should the City decide to order an election, the election "shall be held at the jurisdiction's next regular election occurring not less than 88 days after the date of the order of election."
- Article VII, Section 700 of the City's Charter provides for general municipal elections to be held in the City on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in each even-numbered year – November 3, 2026.



Analysis – Special Election

- Pursuant to Elections Code 1405(b), the City may also "call a special election for the purpose of submitting an initiative measure to the voters before the date on which the initiative measure would appear."
 - Special election to be held not less than 88 days, nor more than 103 days after the order of the election.
- Should the City Council elect to call a special election, staff also requests adoption of Resolution Nos. 2025-09, 2025-10, 2025-11, and 2025-12.

Election Costs

- Orange County Registrar of Voters (ROV) provided the following costs of submittal for the initiative to the voters:
 - November 3, 2026, General Election: \$340,515 -\$399,499
 - Special Election: \$1,190,478 \$1,315,405
 - Cost to add second initiative: \$8,500
- The cost is in addition to \$54,702.60 due to ROV for verification of signatures.



Recommended Action

- Receive and File this Report; and,
- Adopt Ordinance No. 4239, "An Ordinance of the City of Huntington Beach Amending the Huntington Beach Municipal Code by Deleting Chapter 2.66 Thereof and Adding New Section 2.30.090 Thereof;" OR,
- Submit Citizen Initiative to the Voters at the next General Election, November 3, 2026; **OR**,
- Call for a Special Election to be Held Not Less than 88 Days, nor more than 103 days after order of the election; OR,
- Do not approve, and direct staff accordingly.
