COASTAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT NO. 25-020 (BLUFF TOP SLOPE REMEDIATION)

REQUEST:

To repair slope failure along a section of the existing bike path, between the Dog Beach Blufftop parking lots. Project activities would include removal of failed soil and debris, reconstruction of the slope, installation of erosion control fabric, installation of drought resistant landscaping with irrigation, and reconstruction of the bike path.

LOCATION:

20201 Pacific Coast Highway (Assessor's Parcel No. 023-170-14), 92648 - (West side of Pacific Coast Highway between the Dog Beach Blufftop parking lots).

Recommended Action:

That the Zoning Administrator take the following actions:

- A) The proposed project is Categorically Exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301, 15302, 15304, and 15308, Classes 1, 2, 4, and 8.

- B) Approve Coastal Development Permit No. 25-020 with suggested findings and conditions of approval.

26-187 **CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 24-008 (LIBERTY DUPLEX)**

REQUEST:

To demolish an existing single-family residence and construct a three-story duplex, at an overall height of 33 feet 5 inches. This request also includes the construction of two detached ADU's.

LOCATION:

7812 Liberty Drive, 92647 (South side of Liberty Drive, West of Beach Boulevard)

Recommended Action:

That the Zoning Administrator take the following actions:

- A) Find the proposed project categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15303, Class 3; and

- B) Approve Conditional Use Permit No. 24-008, with suggested findings and conditions of approval (Attachment No. 1).

26-192 **CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 24-011/MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION NO. 24-002 (REDONDO CIRCLE INDUSTRIAL PROJECT) - CONTINUED FROM THE JANUARY 21, 2026, ZONING ADMINISTRATOR MEETING**

REQUEST:

CUP: To remove an existing lumber yard and all associated site improvements and construct two industrial warehouse buildings, approximately 40 ft. high, totaling 185,912 sq. ft., with each building containing two office/mezzanine floor units and a truck loading dock on an approximately 9.59-acre site. MND: To analyze the potential environmental impacts associated with the project.

LOCATION:

7600 Redondo Circle, 92648 (at the Terminus of Redondo Circle)

Recommended Action:

That the Zoning Administrator take the following actions:

- A) Approve Mitigated Negative Declaration No. 24-002 with suggested findings and mitigation measures and
- B) Approve Conditional Use Permit No. 24-011 with suggested findings and conditions of approval.
