## Overview



On 12/21/2021, the City Council voted affirmatively to introduce the Huntington Beach Municipal Teamsters (HBMT) labor agreement for formal consideration

▶ 345 Members

MOU expired in December 2021

## Proposed Memorandum of Understanding



Huntington Beach Municipal Teamsters (HBMT)

- ▶ 3-year agreement (Jan. 1, 2022 Dec. 31, 2024)
- ► 2% wage increase
- Opportunity to earn additional step increase, and up to 3% merit-based lump sum bonus for top-step employees
- City's medical plan contribution to increase by average of ~\$67 / month in Year 1, \$23 / month in Year 2
- Formal incorporation of two City-paid holidays (Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve)
- ► The average annual cost of this overall agreement is \$1.15M

## City Council Options



- Approve the Proposed Successor Memorandum of Understanding with HBMT
- Do not approve the adoption of the proposed agreement, and direct staff to:
  - 1) Continue to meet and confer with the Association, or
  - 2) Utilize the impasse procedures contained within the City's Employer-Employee Relations Resolution
