

ORDINANCE NO. 4275

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH
AMENDING CHAPTER 13.08 OF THE HUNTINGTON BEACH MUNICIPAL
CODE RELATING TO DOGS AND OTHER ANIMALS

The City Council of the City of Huntington Beach does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 13.08.070 of the Huntington Beach Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 13.08.070 Dogs and Other Animals.

A. No Person having the care, charge or control of any animal, domesticated or wild, shall permit or allow said animal to be on the Pier or on or upon that Beach or Adjacent Beach Area bounded by the Beach Service Road and the Pacific Ocean, including the Water Activity Zone, unless expressly permitted by a specific event permit. This section shall not apply to a police service animal, or guide dog, signal dog or service dog as defined in Penal Code Section 365.5. This section shall not apply to the Adjacent Beach Areas, and the Water Activity Zone, located north of the line created by extending the northern curb line of 22nd Street to the Pacific Ocean to Seapoint Avenue, wherein dogs constrained by a leash no longer than six feet in length are permitted.

B. No Person shall permit any animal, domesticated or wild, to be left unattended on the Beach or Adjacent Beach Area.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its adoption.
