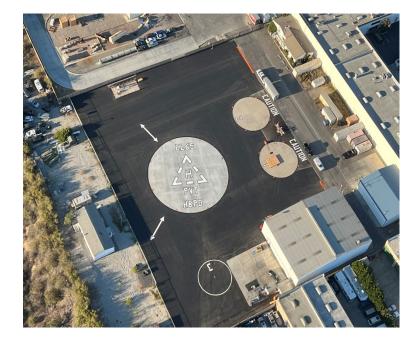

### STREETS (AVG PCI = 81.5)

- Rehabilitating 1.5 miles of arterials (\$5.6M)
  - Banning/Hamilton/Saybrook
- Zone 2 Maintenance (Completed 12 of 12 Zones)
  - Overlay 8 miles of residential streets (\$3.5M)
     Construction in April.
  - Slurry 7 miles of residential streets (\$850k) Construction in April.
  - Added over 100 new ADA ramps (\$665k)

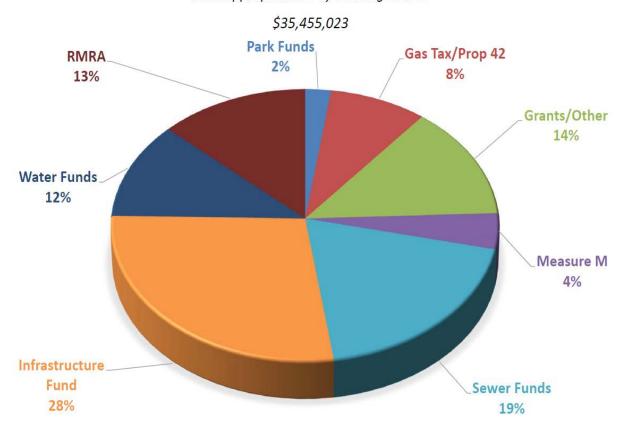

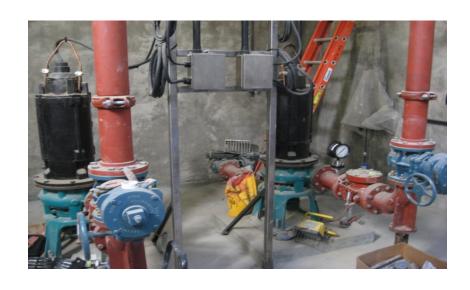
