# BACKGROUND

- Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant transportation shortfalls statewide.



# NEED/WHY/BENEFITS

- Based on the City of Huntington Beach's population, it is estimated the City will receive \$4,917,993 in FY 2023/24 for use on eligible street and transportation projects.
- A pre-requisite to receiving the funds is the submittal of a City Council resolution to identify proposed projects that will utilize this funding.



# DETAILS

- The proposed Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget for FY 2023/24 identifies the use of these funds, in addition to other local funds, for the annual Arterial Rehabilitation Project.
- Proposed arterial segments to rehabilitate:
  - Magnolia (Atlanta to Indianapolis)
  - Hamilton (Magnolia to Bushard)
  - Orange (Goldenwest to 17th)
  - Heil (Saybrook to Bolsa Chica)
  - Garfield (Brookhurst to city limits)
