


General Community Attitudes

Nearly 8-in-10 respondents rate Huntington Beach as either an "excellent" or "good" place to live with almost none calling it "poor."






Consistent with findings from other communities in the current environment, views on the direction of the City are mixed.

Homelessness is highest priority issue for Huntington Beach residents.



Ranked by Extremely/Very Serious Problem





Satisfaction with City Services


Two-thirds are satisfied with the job the City government is doing in providing services to residents and businesses





Huntington Beach residents are also largely satisfied with many services provided by the city.





Specifically at beaches, there is a strong sense of need to improve the safety, cleanliness and maintenance of bathrooms.








