

Project Description:

Replacement of approximately 7,500 lineal feet of galvanized steel railing along the beach bluff from 11th Street to approximately 2,000 feet south of Seapoint Street. Proposed project is to replace the existing galvanized steel railing with wood, lodge pole railing. The lodge pole design will be consistent with the existing railing pattern, matching the spacing and height of vertical posts and rails. The natural wood color of the posts and rails will also be similar in tone to the beige color of the existing railing.


The new railing will be placed in the same line of the existing railing along the bluff.




Existing Rail Design Detail




TYPICAL GUARDRAIL ELEVATION








