Page 10 of the November 18, 2019 minutes requires a revision, and staff is recommending that the Council consider and approve the following change:

Mayor Pro Tem Semeta explained how Orange County cities were prepared to support a fair and equitable formula for distribution, but last minute actions of representatives from the cities of Riverside and Los Angeles to create a new methodology forced a large portion of the affordable housing distribution onto Orange County. She further described how, ***due to the last minute notice which lacked analysis and specificity***, Orange County was ***not given sufficient opportunity*** ~~unprepared to respond~~ ***on the methodology which shifted large unit allocations onto Orange County. Ms. Semeta specifically was denied the opportunity to comment at the meeting*** ~~before the final vote that included participation by representatives from larger cities in Riverside, Los Angeles and San Bernardino counties, resulting in the unfair expectation for Huntington Beach.~~
