REPORTING, AND OPENNESS IN NEGOTIATIONS DISCLOSURES

Page 10 of the November 18, 2019 minutes requires a revision, and staff is recommending that the Council consider and approve the following change:

Mayor Pro Tem Semeta explained how Orange County cities were prepared to support a fair and equitable formula for distribution, but last minute actions of representatives from the cities of Riverside and Los Angeles to create a new methodology forced a large portion of the affordable housing distribution onto Orange County. She further described how. due to the last minute notice which lacked analysis and specificity, Orange County was not given sufficient opportunity-unprepared to respond on the methodology which shifted large unit allocations onto Orange County. Ms. Semeta specifically was denied the opportunity to comment at the meeting before the final vote that included participation by representatives from larger cities in Riverside, Los Angeles and San Bernardino counties, resulting in the unfair expectation for Huntington Beach.
