It was noted that Edgewater Lift Station should be complete in November. The Public Works managers manage the funds. Chair Cicerone questioned the fund balances. Ken Dills responded noting that State law allows the City to build a balance in order to do high dollar projects like lift stations or intersection improvements.

On motion by Capps and second by Mulvihill the Commission voted to 1) recommend to the City Council the approval of the Annual Sanitary Sewer Facilities Fund Compliance Report for FY 18/19; 2) recommend to the City Council the approval of the Planned Local Drainage Facility Fund Compliance Report for FY 18/19; and 3) recommend approval of the 18/19 Traffic Impact Fee Annual Report to the City Council.
