ASCON LANDFILL SITE UPDATE

► CURRENT STATUS

- Clean-up efforts Stopped since June
- ASCON is pursuing tenting/enclosure permits and work plan approval
- ASCON Completed the Hamilton Berm Emergency Repair.
 - The work started on April 21st and completed on May 8th.

NORTH BERM REPAIR COMPLETE

►TIMELINE

- December 31, 2019 and February 6, 2020 ASCON identified tension cracks on the berm along Hamilton
- February April 2020 DTSC and ASCON evaluated options to repair and alleviate slope failure.
- April 2, 2020 Online community forum on emergency repair work
- April 10, 2020 DTSC provided approval letter for ASCON to proceed
 - Outlined strict conditions for all repair work to mitigate any impacts to the community
- April 20, 2020 ASCON commenced the Managed Excavation of the Hamilton Berm under oversight of DTSC
- May 8, 2020 Managed Excavation Completed.

CURRENT SITE ACTIVITES

▶ Week of May 18th

- Demobilization of the North Berm repair equipment and water filled barriers on Hamilton Ave.
- The managed excavation was conducted with air quality monitoring in the work zone, at the perimeter of Ascon, and at locations in the community. There were no offsite public health impacts detected.
- Ascon continues to work with SCAQMD on permitting a pilot project on the feasibility of tenting areas of the Site during excavation work.
- Continued field activity at Ascon to maintain the Site. Including dust control, weed abatement, vector control, Stormwater protections and 24 hour site security.
- Continued Air monitoring and sampling of on-site and off-site stations with results posted on DTSC's Enviorstor and on AsconHB.org.
