

ORDINANCE NO. 4218

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH AMENDING HUNTINGTON
BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTERS 10.50 and 10.52 RELATING CITY PAY
PARKING LOTS AND OFF-STREET CITY PARKING LOTS

The City Council of the City of Huntington Beach does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection D of Section 10.50.020 of the Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

“D No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle in violation of any properly noticed curfew as established by the City Manager or the Director of Community Services.”

SECTION 2. Subsection D of Section 10.52.020 of the Municipal Code is added to read as follows:

“D No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle in violation of any properly noticed curfew as established by the City Manager or the Director of Community Services.”

SECTION 3. Section 10.52.025 is added to the Municipal Code to read as follows:

“10.52.025 Electric Charging Stalls and Spaces

A. The Director of Community Services is authorized to designate stalls or spaces in the City’s off-street parking lots for the exclusive purpose of charging and parking a vehicle that is connected for electric charging purposes.

B. No person shall park in an electric charging stall or space except when connected to an electric charging station.

C. No person shall obstruct, block, or otherwise bar access to an electric charging station.”

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its adoption.



10.50.020 Payment of Charges Required

- A. The City Council shall establish by Resolution the fees, rates and charges for vehicle parking at all off-street City pay parking lots. Parking meters or attendants may collect the fees, rates, and charges.
- B. No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle upon any off-street City pay parking lot at any time without payment of the fees, rates and charges established for the use of the lot by Resolution of the City Council.
- C. All fees, rates and charges for parking at any off-street City pay parking lot shall be paid in advance in money of the United States of America, except as otherwise provided by validation agreement.
- D. ~~The payment of fees to a parking meter or pay station does not exempt a person or vehicle from receiving a citation for violation of the posted curfew. (4148-2/19)~~ No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle in violation of any properly noticed curfew as established by the City Manager or the Director of Community Services

10.52.020 Additional Off-Street City Parking Lot Regulations

- A. The Director of Community Services is authorized to establish additional regulations regarding the time, place and manner of parking or stopping of vehicles on any off-street City parking lot.
- B. The Director of Community Services shall not enforce any regulation established pursuant to this chapter in any off-street City parking lot until he or she has posted adequate notice of such regulations in the off-street parking lot.
- C. No person shall park or stop a vehicle in any off-street City parking lot in violation of any properly posted regulation established by the Director of Community Services pursuant to this section.
- D. No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle in violation of any properly noticed curfew as established by the City Manager or the Director of Community Services.

10.52.025 Electric Charging Stalls and Spaces

- A. The Director of Community Services is authorized to designate stalls or spaces in the City's off-street parking lots for the exclusive purpose of charging and parking a vehicle that is connected for electric charging purposes.
- B. No person shall part in an electric charging stall or space except when connected to an electric charging station.
- C. No person shall obstruct, block or otherwise bar access to an electric charging station.
