A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH REQUESTING CALTRANS APPROVING THE CLOSING OF PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY AND CERTAIN INGRESS AND EGRESS WITHIN THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH FOR THE ANNUAL SURF CITY 10 RUN

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Huntington Beach desires to support community events and tourism in the City; and

The City of Huntington Beach is a participating host of Surf City 10 Run on September 11, 2021; and

This community event will require the closing of Pacific Coast Highway ("PCH"), and the left turn pocket on northbound PCH at 6th Street, the left turn pocket on northbound PCH to Huntington Street all of which requires approval of CalTrans,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Huntington Beach does hereby resolve as follows:

- 1. To direct the City Manager to request that CalTrans approve the closure of PCH between Beach Boulevard and Warner Avenue on September 11, 2021, to accommodate the participants in the Annual Surf City 10 Run.
- 2. To direct the City Manager to request that CalTrans approve the closure of the left turn pocket on northbound Pacific Coast Highway at 6th Street and the left turn pocket on northbound PCH to Huntington Street on Saturday, September 10, 2021 through Sunday, September 11, 2021 to accommodate event set-up, registration and tear-down.
- 3. To authorize the Director of Public Works to approve the traffic control plans to implement the roadway closures and traffic restrictions.
