Mayor Pro Tem Carr - expressed concerns about Infrastructure Funding and appreciated clarification.

Councilmember Brenden - questioned reduction of 33 position and no impact in services. More services to be outsourced? City Manager Chi confident team will be able to cover gaps.

Councilmember Delgleize: clarified with City Manager Chi responsibilities for new police lieutenant position.

Mayor Semeta asked for clarification of Economic Development blending into another department.
