# **Huntington Beach Ascon Landfill Site Update**

City Council Meeting April 19, 2021



### Project and Site Status

- Site Clean-up Efforts have been stopped since June 2019 as required by DTSC
- Site Maintenance will continue including: Weed Abatement, vector control inspections, Stormwater management measures, dust control measures, and application of soil sealant.
- Continued Air monitoring and sampling of on-site and off-site stations with results posted on DTSC's Enviorstor and on AsconHB.org.
- Ascon Continues to develop overall site remediation plan and testing of canopy technologies.

### Ascon is conducting an Odor Assessment Field Investigation

- > Conduct soil vapor analysis to identify areas with potential to generate odor during the future clean-up
- > Completion of Odor Analysis the end of July 2021



#### • Pit F Remediation Set to Resume in mid-June

- Remediation will occur within the existing tent on site with air treatment system to operate continuously until work is complete
  - Expected to take 3 months to complete
- DTSC to perform Public Outreach and Education over the next month
  - Distribution of Public Notification and Pit F FAQ sheet
  - Information Mailed to 13,000 address located within one-mile radius of the project along with all required entities
  - DSTC/Ascon Coordinated with Edison High School to provide information to all parents and students
  - DTSC provide emails from project update email lists.
