

City Council Vacancy Application

The City of Huntington Beach is now accepting applications to fill a City Council vacancy that terms on December 20 apply, you must be a U.S. citizen, a Huntington Beach resident at the time of application and during the term, and 18 older.

The application deadline is June 18, 2021 at 5:00pm. To apply, fill out an online application at http://bit.ly/hbcitycoungerefer to complete a paper application, please visit the City Clerk's Office at 2000 Main Street, 2nd Floor, Huntington 92648.

Following the submittal of an application, the applicant must interview with the City Council at a future date and time interview dates are scheduled for either June 25-27 or July 9-11, which will decided based on the volume of applications received by the June 18 deadline.

The City Council will consider both the applications and interviews to make a final decision, which will be considered Council Meeting in July 2021.

During the meeting many people spoke in person or or Zoom to promote a candidate. There were two names mentioned throughout: Oscar Rodriguez and Gracey Der Mark.
