Utica Bike Boulevard

- **Bicycle connection as a shared user of the roadway**
 - Beach Boulevard to Main Street. East-West
 - Creates "pass thru": Alabama to Lake
 - New traffic signal at Lake and Utica
- **Funded in prior budget years**
- **Design complete – grant authorization with Caltrans**
- **Construction bidding end of year, (pending permitting) with work in early 2022**



Delaware Street Bike Lanes

- **Design to reallocate extra wide street to:**
 - Keep curb adjacent, on-street parking
 - Provide buffered bike lanes
 - Encourage reduced travel speeds for autos
- **Developing options for intersection treatments**
- **Expectation**
 - Complete design by December
 - Construction early 2022



Goldenwest St. Protected Bike Lane

Central Park to PCH portion (2.75 miles)

Modify striping to provide buffered or protected bike lane

Shipley to Shore Path

Completing efforts to create continuous public path from Edwards/Ellis to near PCH

Rail replacement element starting construction 9/14/2021

Path improvements under design

Path concept:

- Provide separated portions of path for bike use and pedestrians
- Substantial pavement improvement and widening of path
- Enhanced "crossing zone" treatments
