

602 PCH Public Art

Description & Narrative

The proposed artwork is a part of a new development site located at the north corner of Pacific Coast Highway and 6th Street in Huntington Beach. The artwork is a ceramic tile mural mounted on the front surface of a decorative screen wall between a new parking lot and the sidewalk along PCH.


The site is located in one of the most attractive areas along Southern California's Pacific coastline. The iconic Huntington Beach Pier just across PCH from the site was a major inspiration for the artwork.

The artwork evokes a golden sunset washing over the Huntington Beach Pier, ushering in a cool breeze at the end of a warm summer day. While it contains a recognizable depiction of the pier, the artwork relies on abstracted decorative patterns created by juxtaposing the natural environment of the beach and the man-made structure of the pier. The rhythmic vertical pattern becomes the prime compositional element for visually shortening the long and narrow artwork as defined by the constraints of the given layout. The composition relies on high color contrast between the dark elements and the lighter background, as well as more subtle color gradients, providing a sense of depth to the image. This will be an attractive detail to both pedestrian passersby to study at leisure, as well as to car passengers passing the site along PCH.

On the technical end, the mural will be assembled from prefabricated color ceramic tile, sized by a waterjet tool according to the tile maps. It will then be attached to a polymer mesh, delivered map-by-map to the construction site and mounted to prepared surface of the block wall. After the artwork installation is complete, the top and sides of the wall will be covered with black anodized aluminum sheets as flashing and as a frame for the artwork.


Grigori Mikhailik








