My Dear Madam Mayoress,

I am writing to express my support for Item XX, the termination of Huntington Beach's declaration of a state of emergency due to the coronavirus "pandemic."

Huntington Beach has a declining case rate, and an average vaccination rate of 64.9%. the council must begin to recognize the lack of presence of the coronavirus.

In fact, many countries have lifted all remaining restrictions due to high vaccination rates. There is therefore a question of whether the coronavirus truly remains a "pandemic," which is defined as a disease with a global impact.
