- ▶ Huntington Beach Firefighters' Association (HBFA)
 - ▶ 112 members
 - ▶ MOU expired in June 2021
- ▶ Fire Management Association
 - 8 members
 - ▶ MOU expired in September 2017
- Proposed MOUs seek greater alignment between Fire associations to increase employee retention & encourage continuing education

Proposed Memoranda of Understanding



Huntington Beach Firefighters' Association (HBFA)

- 2.5-year agreement (July 1, 2021 Dec. 31, 2023)
- Opportunity to earn additional step increase, and up to 3% merit-based lump sum bonus for top-step employees
- Increase employee CalPERS cost sharing by 1% (to the max. of 13%)
- City's medical plan contribution to increase by ~\$60 / month in Year 1, \$23 in Year 2
- Holiday-in-Lieu & specialty pay adjustments
- The average annual cost of this overall agreement is \$1.1M

Huntington Beach Fire Management Association (FMA)

- 2.5-year agreement (July 1, 2021 Dec. 31, 2023)
- Opportunity to earn up to 3% meritbased lump sum bonus for top-step employees
- Increase employee CalPERS cost sharing by 2% (to the max. of 13%)
- City's medical plan contribution to increase by ~\$90 / month, \$23 in Year 2
- Education, specialty, and longevity pay updates
- The average annual cost of this overall agreement is \$97,357
