

OUTLINE/PROPOSAL

OBJECTIVE

To go back to include a localized videotaped parade coverage for documentation and playback on HBTV3 and City's YOUTUBE.

HOW

To stage multi-cam coverage further up Main Street near the Art Center

WHO

Team consists of parade hosts, Matt Liffreing & Alyssa Welfringer, both with parade experience; Greg T Furlong (Camera) & Jeff Highbaugh (Camera), associated aerial spot coverage by Joe Annello and some taped roll ins from local influencers along the parade route is what is needed, including a few production assistants and requested RACES member to keep us informed
