• Financial Report

T. Hopkins, S. Rief and D. Bulosan presented budget to date. Committee wants to see detailed franchise fees. In addition, the Committee would like a breakdown of expenses (i.e. equipment – budget was for \$45K and spent \$92K).

Programming Update

J. Toledo presented new ideas for programming. The Committee decided upon a new show entitled: MyHB. The First episode will feature services on the MyHB app, but also feature a 'trip inside city hall' – How do you interface with City Hall? Other MyHB ideas include:

- PD Senior fraud, bike theft (how to register your bike), fireworks, coyotes, graffiti
- Surf Museum/Surf Culture
- Public Art Program
- Walking tour with Chris Epting of Downtown and Sunset Beach

Other suggestions included contacting the four high school digital media arts instructors to obtain content so the each school could have its own hour of programming. J. Toledo would also look into costs for a "Game of the Week." The Committee also suggested reaching out to the American Legion Post 133 for video content on its Vets. Lastly, J. Toledo reported that students from Marina High School were putting together Census 2020 videos. The Communications Committee will vote on the best video to play on Channel 3.

4th of July/KABC

The Committee discussed the renew contract with these provisions:

- \$20K donation to 4th of July Parade
- One-year contract
- Barricades and extra security covered
- Copy of uninterrupted parade coverage to play on channel 3 immediately after parade In addition the Committee suggested looking at other parades in other markets
