STATE ITEMS

August 31 at 1:15am was the end of hearings regarding all legislation, and it was reported to have been one of the most eventful and entertaining sessions ever. A lot of bills were not passed because of Covid-19 related quarantines and the necessity of Senate Republicans to meet virtually.

Pending Legislation

The Governor has until September 30 to sign the bills that did pass, or to veto them. The bills that Townsend has been watching for the City are on the Governor's desk.

Local Ballot Measures

The IRC has asked that the following Propositions be brought to the next City Council meeting for approval of resolutions:

Proposition 15 – Increases Funding Sources For Public Schools, Community Colleges, And Local Government Services By Changing Tax Assessment Of Commercial And Industrial Property, “Eliminates Prop 13 on certain commercial properties” – **OPPOSE**

Proposition 22 – Exempts App-Based Transportation and Delivery Companies from Providing Employee Benefits to Certain Drivers, “Rolls back certain aspects of AB5 for transportation and delivery drivers” - **SUPPORT**

FEDERAL ITEMS

1. Phase 4 Funding: Townsend continues to push for local government support. There is legislation with the House that will provide \$500 billion to local governments, and House Speaker Pelosi has stated that the House will not recess until a package has been approved.
2. Coalition Against Bigger Trucks (CABT): **WATCH**
3. Resolution to End Child Marriage: **WATCH**
