### **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

#### 1. State

- a. Townsend provided a general legislative update.
- b. May Revise. Townsend provided an update to Governor Newsom's inflation package of \$48B, and briefly discussed gas tax rebate options.
- c. Housing
  - i. AB 2050 (Lee) Ellis Act inactive on Assembly floor.
  - ii. AB 2011 (Wicks) Affordable Housing and High Road Jobs Act of 2022 was opposed by IRC in May 2022. Watching carefully as it has passed Assembly floor and moving into Senate Housing.
  - iii. AB 2386 (Bloom) Exclusive occupancy agreement. Failed to pass Assembly floor.

### d. Miscellaneous

- i. AB 2357 (Ting) Surplus land. Withdrawn by Ting.
- ii. AB 2496 (Petrie-Norris) Loud vehicle noise. Heading to Senate Transportation Committee on 6/28/22. Amendment to include motorcycle noise.
- iii. SB 1079 (Portantino) Sound-activated enforcement devices lacks support due to enforcement issues.
- iv. SB 1338 (Umberg) CARE Court. City has supported.
- v. CalTrans permit extension was discussed related to signage adjacent to freeway.

### 2. Federal

a. FY 2023 Appropriations. Oak View Library has been earmarked \$3M from Senator Padilla and \$500k from Senator Feinstein. The Mobile Crisis Response has been earmarked \$1.5M by Sen. Padilla. Staff has submitted an application for a current earmark of \$500k from Senator Feinstein. And

- \$2.5M has been requested for the Navigation Center. Senator Feinstein is on the Appropriations Committee.
- b. WRDA Inclusion Huntington Beach Bluff Stabilization Project. ACOE has been authorized to work on the project, however, funding has not been made available. This project is expected to be multi-year.
