## Subject:

**Revisions to the Senior Accountant Job Class Specification** 

The **Senior Accountant** job classification is assigned to the Finance Department and represented by the Huntington Beach Municipal Teamsters (HBMT).

Modifications to the **Senior Accountant** job class specification are recommended to: 1) add reporting relationships; 2) update job duties; 3) update minimum qualifications including experience and licensing requirements and certification preference in accordance with the needs of the position and department; 4) add DMV Employer Pull Program notice and Disaster Service Worker requirements; and 5) update the physical tasks and environmental conditions. These modifications are intended to update the classification to reflect current and consistent job requirements and present hiring standards, and do not materially change the fundamental nature of the work performed. The current pay grade remains the same.

The Finance Department collaborated with Human Resources on the recommended changes, and HBMT has reviewed the proposed changes.
