HBSC Partners Proposal Concession Update

Permits Issued Goldenwest Concession

- COFO Issued – Fees Paid - \$180.20
- Sign Permit Issued – Fees Paid - \$440.00
- Patio Construction Permit Issued - \$3953.08
- It appears there were no penalties paid for operating without a COFO for 15 months and putting up signage on our public buildings and doing construction without permits on our city owned property
- Key take-away – What message does this send the public?

Talbert Concession

- Still not open – Took keys in October 2024 – Approaching 2 years
- In Violation of Lease – Needs to be open 100 days per calendar year
- Will speak with city attorney about next steps
- What good is an agreement if city does not enforce it?

Menus:

During the walkthrough, it was noted that only one of the two concession buildings is equipped with an industrial hood for cooking. Recognizing this limitation, HBSC has developed two menus uniquely suited to the constraints of the facilities. The Northside (Fields 5-8) and Southside (Fields 1-4) locations will each feature their own signature items while serving similar complimentary items. In addition, we feel that through proper signage and app-based ordering, we can share the diverse offerings of both locations with customers throughout the park.

- Operational Year

(d) **Operational Year.** The "Operational Year" is defined as a one-year period ending December 31 of each year.

- Concession must be open 100 days per year – Page 8 of Lease

SECTION 10. BUSINESS PURPOSES AND USE OF PREMISES.

The Premises are leased for the purpose of operation of two Sports Park food and beverage facilities offering a menu comparable to **Exhibit B**, including use of food carts. Any material alteration of the menu shall be approved by CITY.

At all times, LESSEE shall comply with the following requirements:

(a) LESSEE, at its sole cost and expense shall equip, operate, manage, and maintain the Premises in good safe working condition.

(b) LESSEE shall operate the Premises for a minimum of 100 "Operational Days" during the calendar year, provided the LESSEE may close for up to ten (10) verified rain days. In no case shall the Premises be operating for less than 90 Operational Days per year. An "Operational Day" is defined as the Premises being open for business a minimum of four (4) consecutive hours.
