The Board reviewed the draft and provided input. Mr. Santiago shared he would like to see a larger margin, especially at the top and bottom of the plaque. He recommended a half inch all the way around. He also stated, having different font sizes can make it easier to read. Along with moving the City logo and canons up, after the main text and before the list of City Council members. This will create a nice break from the text. Ms. Nguyen recommending verifying the canons depicted are historically accurate. Ms. Mekis recommended removing the word “that” before, Freedom is not free. Mr. Santiago suggested placing a period after ‘our great nation’ removing ‘and reminding us that.’ The Board also felt the smoke from the canons did not look cohesive and asked if there were different smoke options.

Ms Mekis moved to recommend the edits to City Staff and the Community and Library Services Commission, seconded by Ms. Nguyen. Motion passed unanimously. 7-0.
